Thank you for your document titled, "Yellowjacket Gold Project BC Small Mines Act Application for an Open Pit Mine and Gravity Concentrating Plant" (Volume 1) and Appendices (Volume 2) which we received on April 14, 2009.

As per my email of April 4, 2009, MEMPR has screened the Application. Deficiencies noted in the Application were:

- No cover letter that actually would constitute an application as required in Part 10 of the code was received by MEMPR;
- Page 100, Section 7.2 Site Water Balance states that a preliminary site water balance model has yet to be prepared for this project;
- No Traffic Control Plan is provided. Part 6.8.3 of the code describes a "Traffic Control Plan" requirements;
- A Surface Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Plan (SEPSC) is not provided;
- There is no design for the proposed 2009 and further tailings facilities;
- References to other documents is not sufficient for characterization of climate, hydrology, aquatic life, wildlife, vegetation, rare or endangered species for a Project of this scope.
- Unsigned reports cannot be accepted. Reports must be signed and sealed, as appropriate, by the applicable professional, inclusive of a signature page.

More comments will be forthcoming. At this time, MEMPR will accept your Application for review, however, missing or incomplete information may cause delays in processing the application. Please submit the additional information noted. Regular scheduled meetings of the Northwest Mine Development Review Committee will be scheduled to review the application upon receipt of the additional information.

10.1.4 (i) source, use and water balance for any water required in the operation,
10.1.4 (j) overall site water balance.

10.1.4 (k) a traffic control procedure as required under section 6.8.3 of this code.
